Class Description

Extreme Discipleship

We are involved primarily in the disciplines of the Christian faith and the call to embrace the character of Christ. There will be study materials, workbooks, reading books, devotional practices and the practical applications of the subjects we address. As a class we will engage in a deeper walk with Christ and dependency on the Holy Spirit. This is a power-packed class filled with great curriculum and a lot practical application.

Christian Faith 101

This class is an introduction to the doctrinal essentials of the Christian faith. New Testament Survey

New Testament Survey will take you from the Gospels to Revelation and give you an overview of all the books included. You will be amazed at how much you learn from this terrific curriculum.
